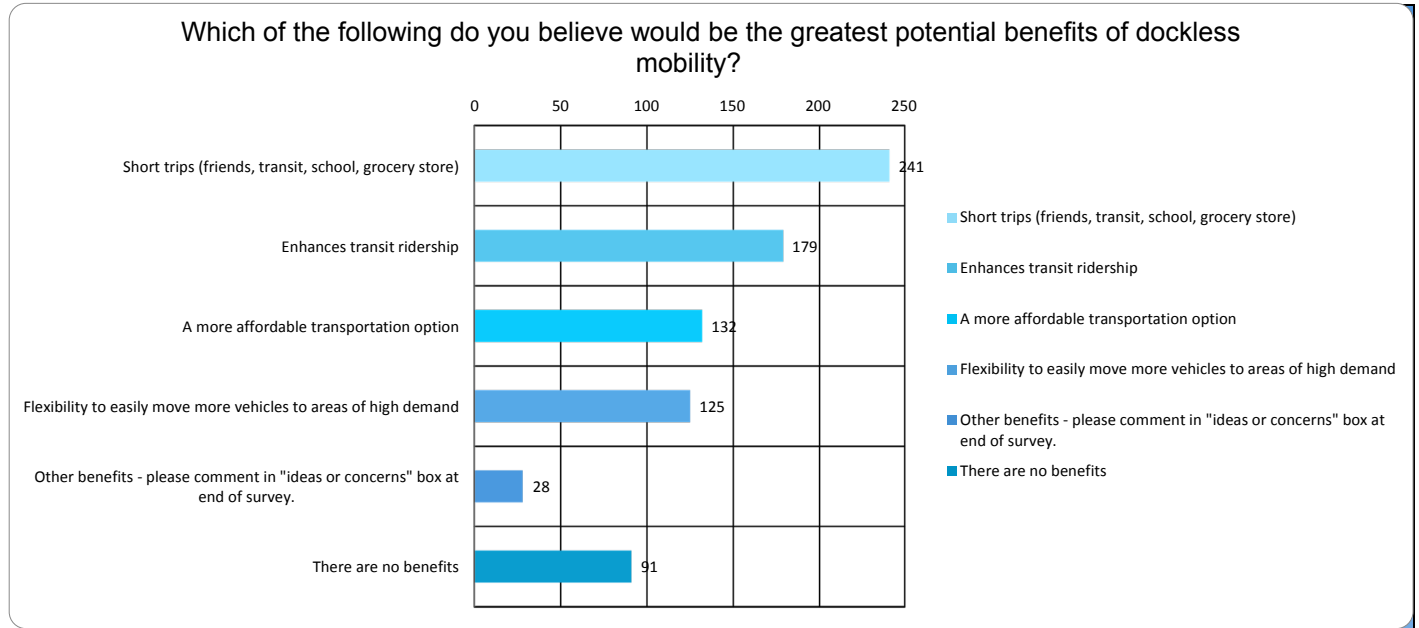

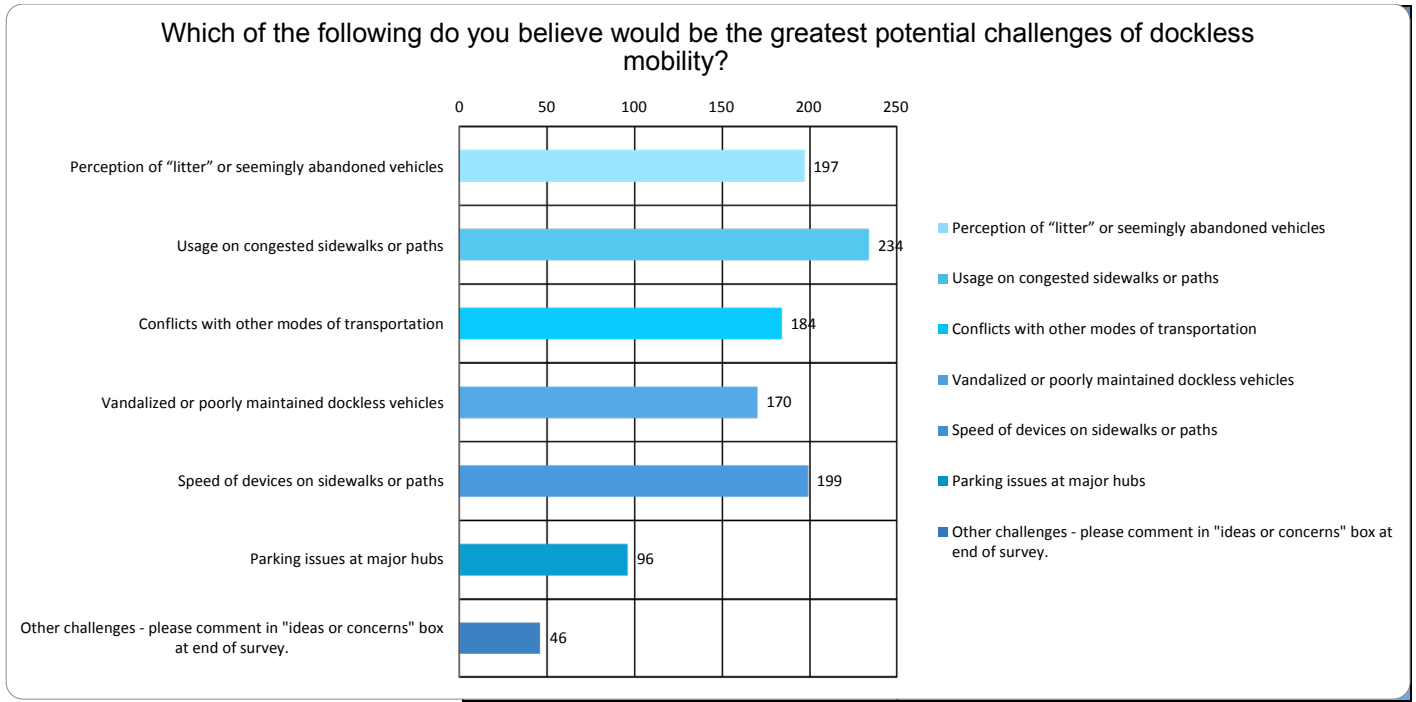

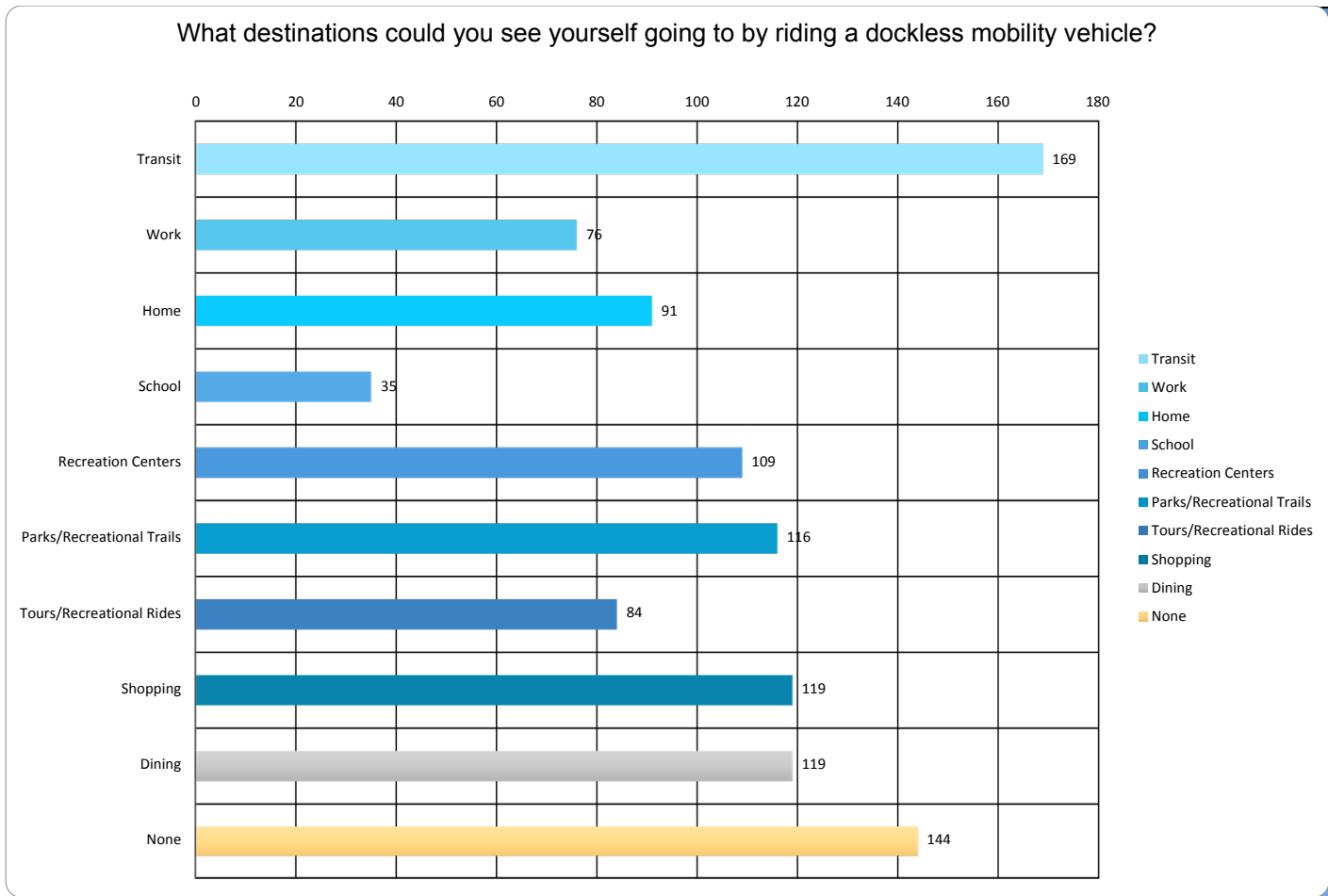

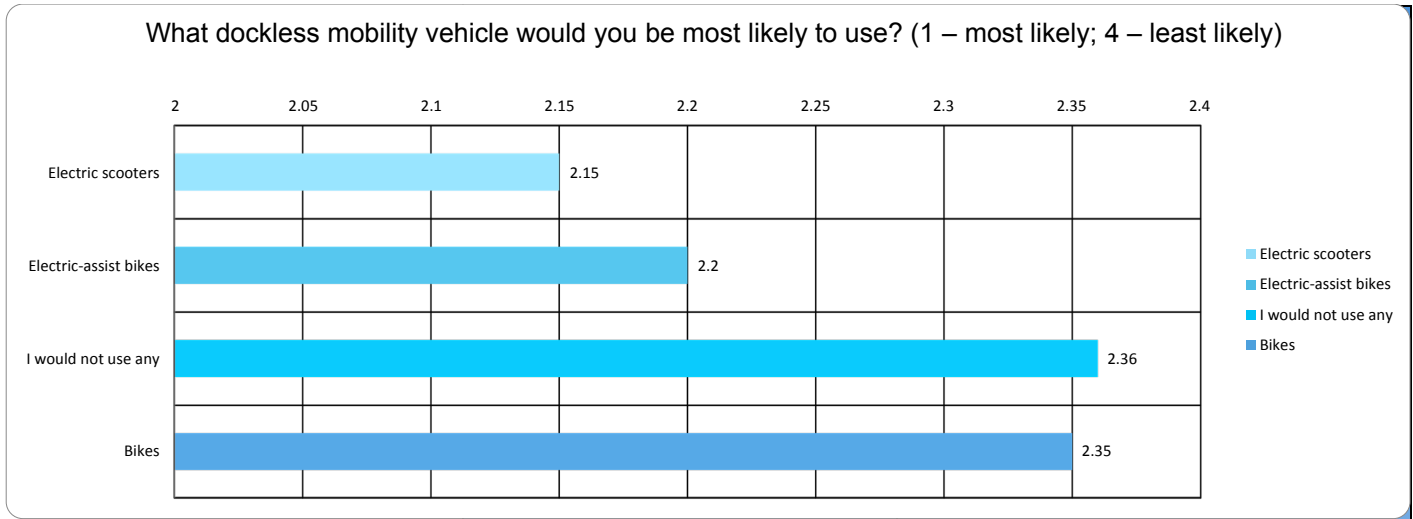

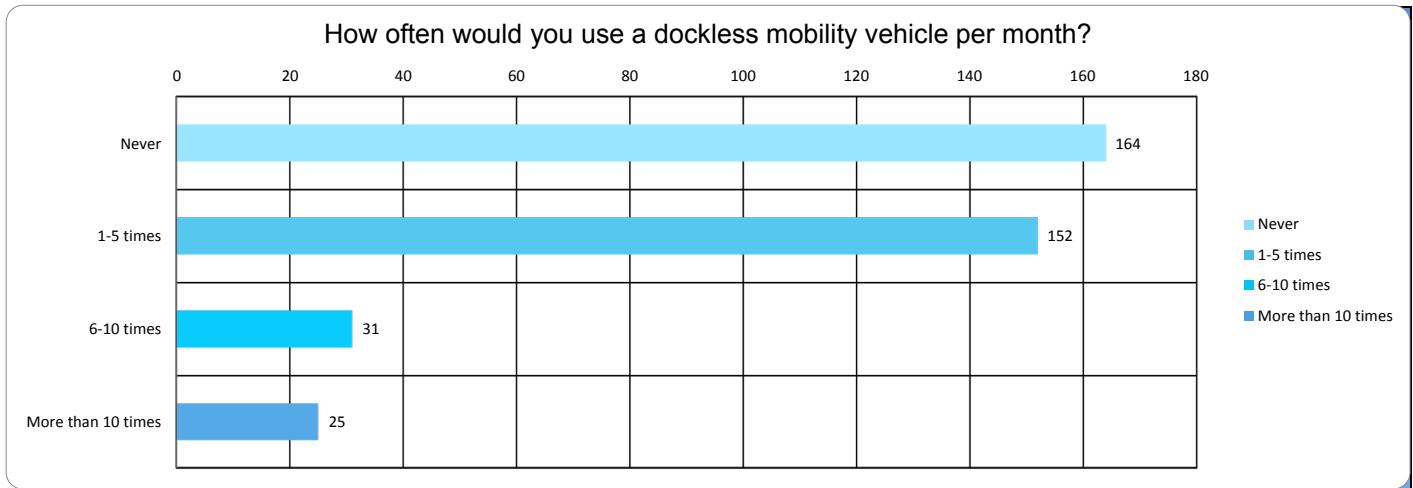

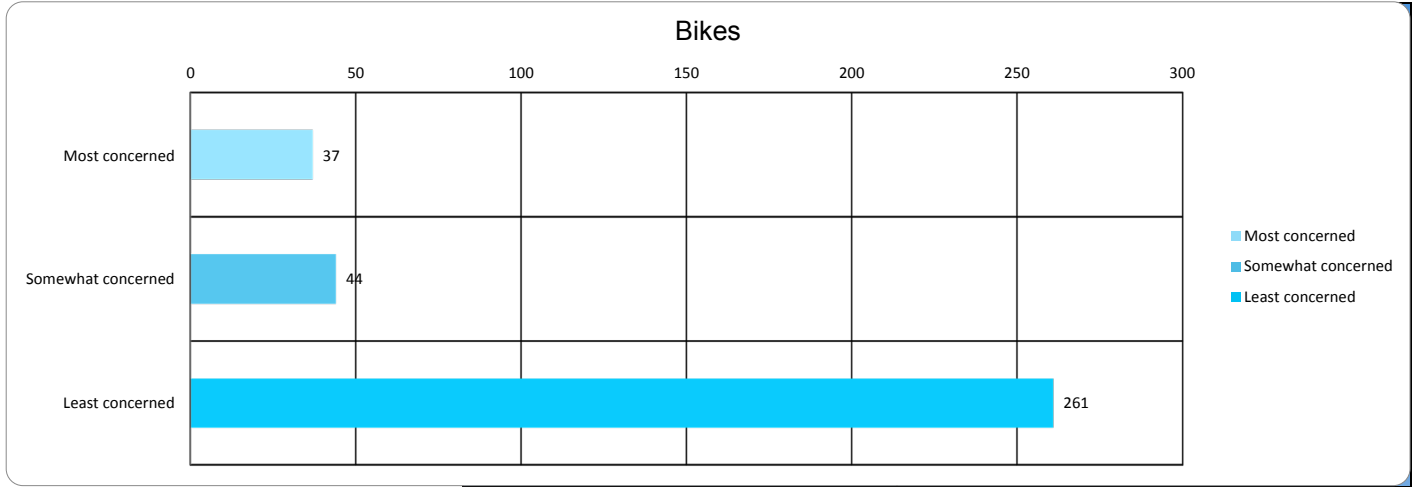

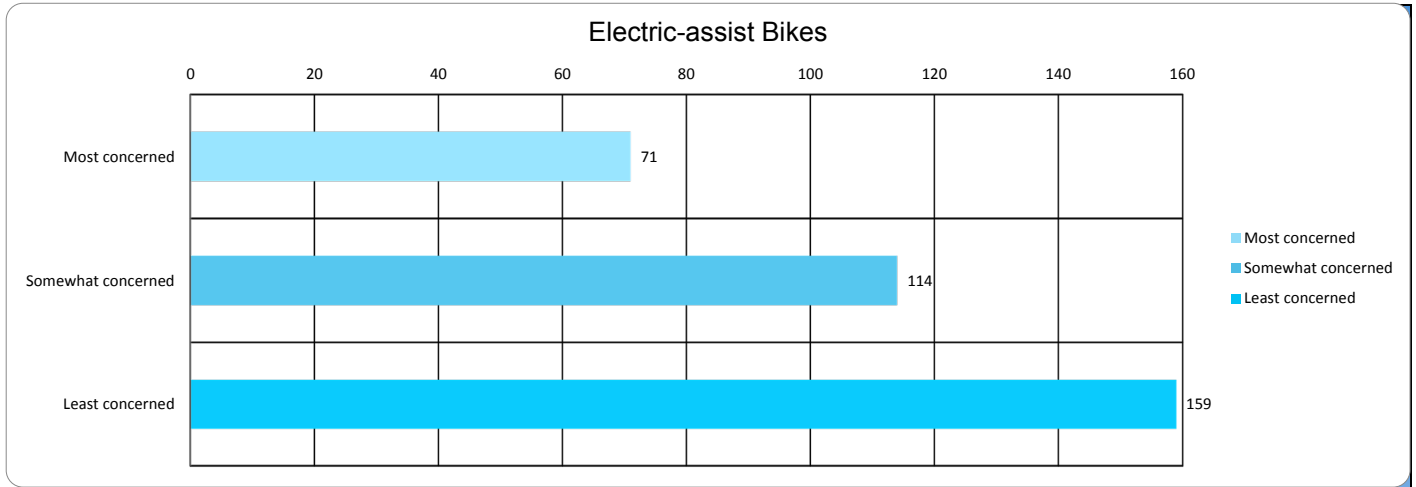
Which kind of vehicles are you most concerned about allowing in Lakewood?

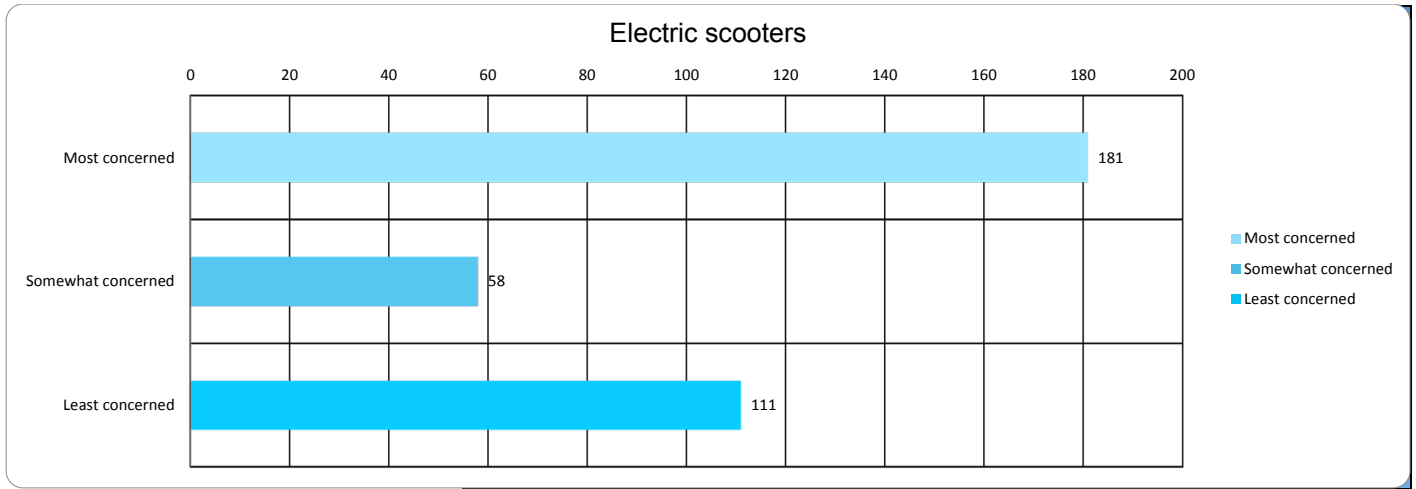

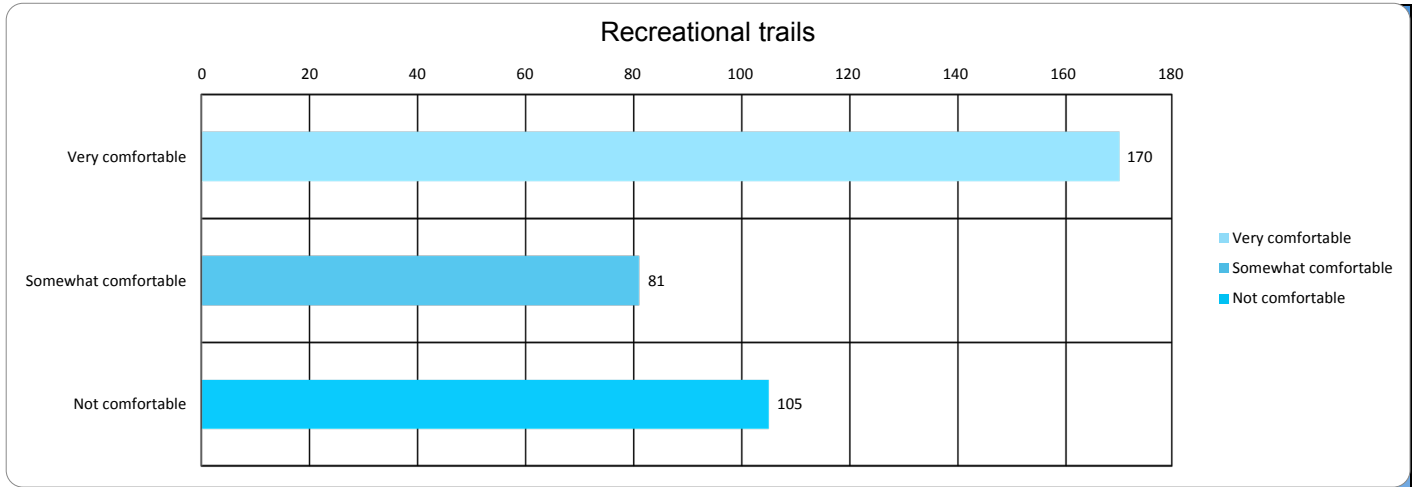

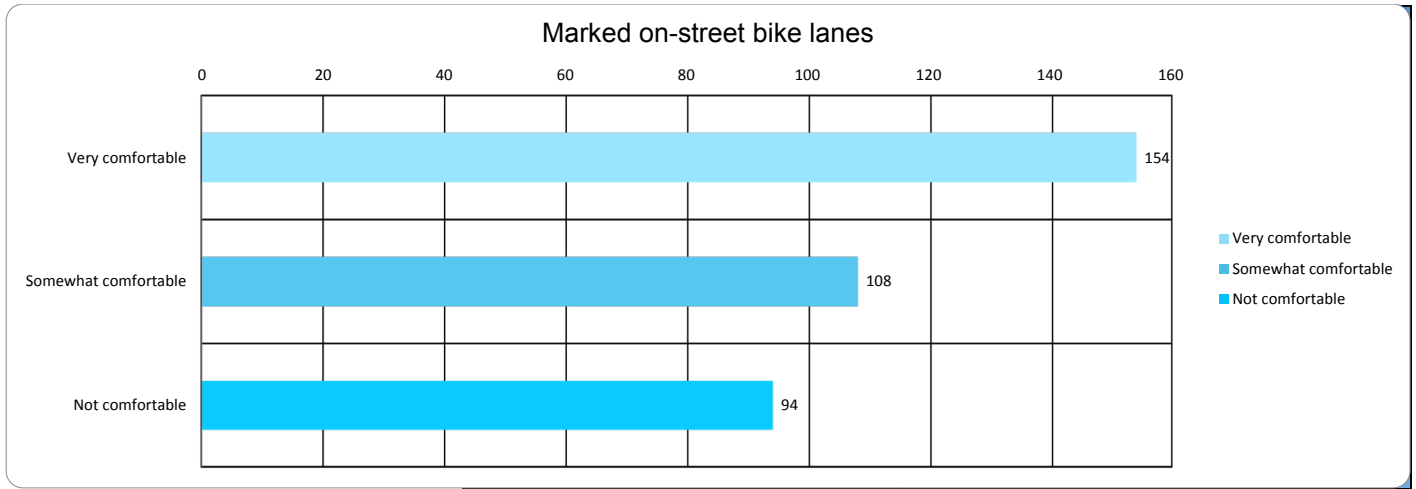
Where would you feel most comfortable riding electric scooters?

Where do you feel most comfortable riding electric scooters?

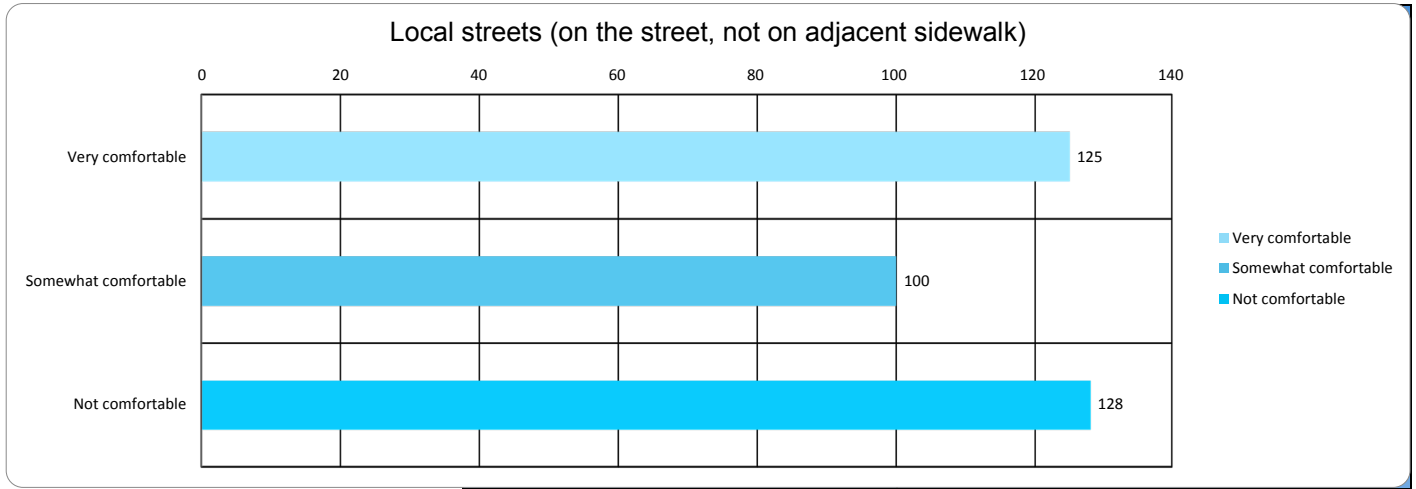

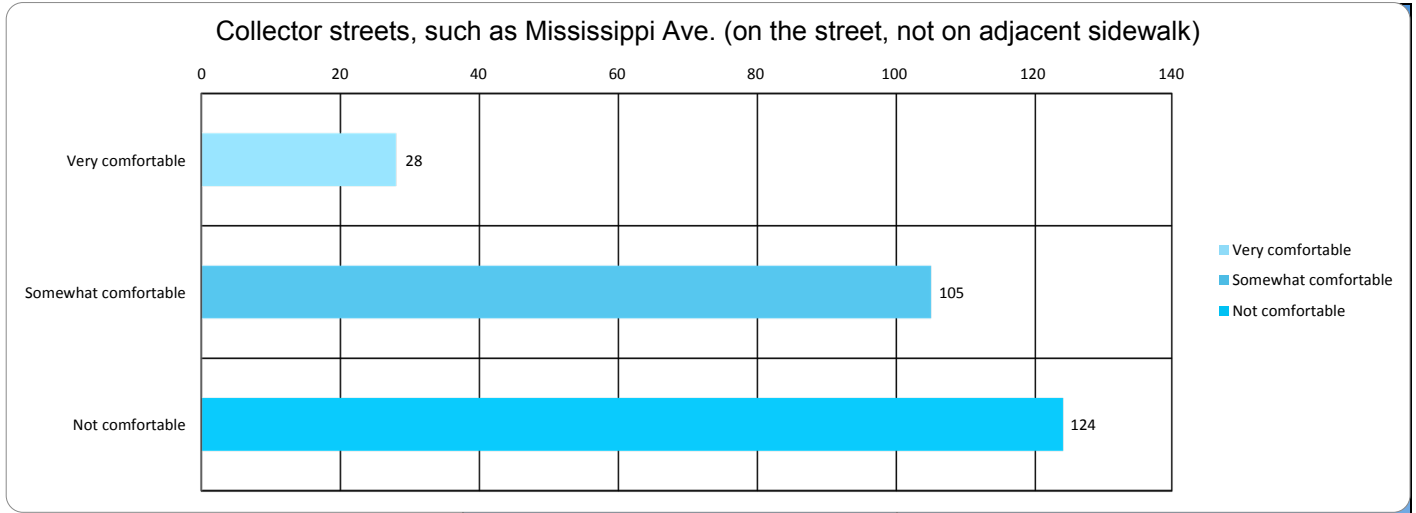
