A RESOLUTION

APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR IMPROVEMENTS ALONG WADSWORTH BOULEVARD NEAR MORRISON ROAD AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAID AGREEMENT AND AN AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Lakewood has been awarded a grant to add a shared-use path along the east side of Wadsworth Boulevard between approximately Vassar Avenue and Woodard Avenue;

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to approve an intergovernmental agreement (IGA) with the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) for the path grant;

WHEREAS, the City has been awarded an additional grant for motor vehicle improvements in the same area and such grant will result in an amendment to the IGA with CDOT to expand the project scope and modify the funding;

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to approve the expanded scope and additional funding that will be the subject of the IGA amendment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby finds and determines that authorizing the City Manager to execute the IGA and the IGA amendment is in the best interest of the residents of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lakewood, Colorado, that:

SECTION 1. The IGA is hereby approved and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into the IGA on behalf of the City.

SECTION 2. An IGA amendment, as necessary to incorporate the grant for motor vehicle improvements, is hereby approved and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into said IGA amendment on behalf of the City.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
